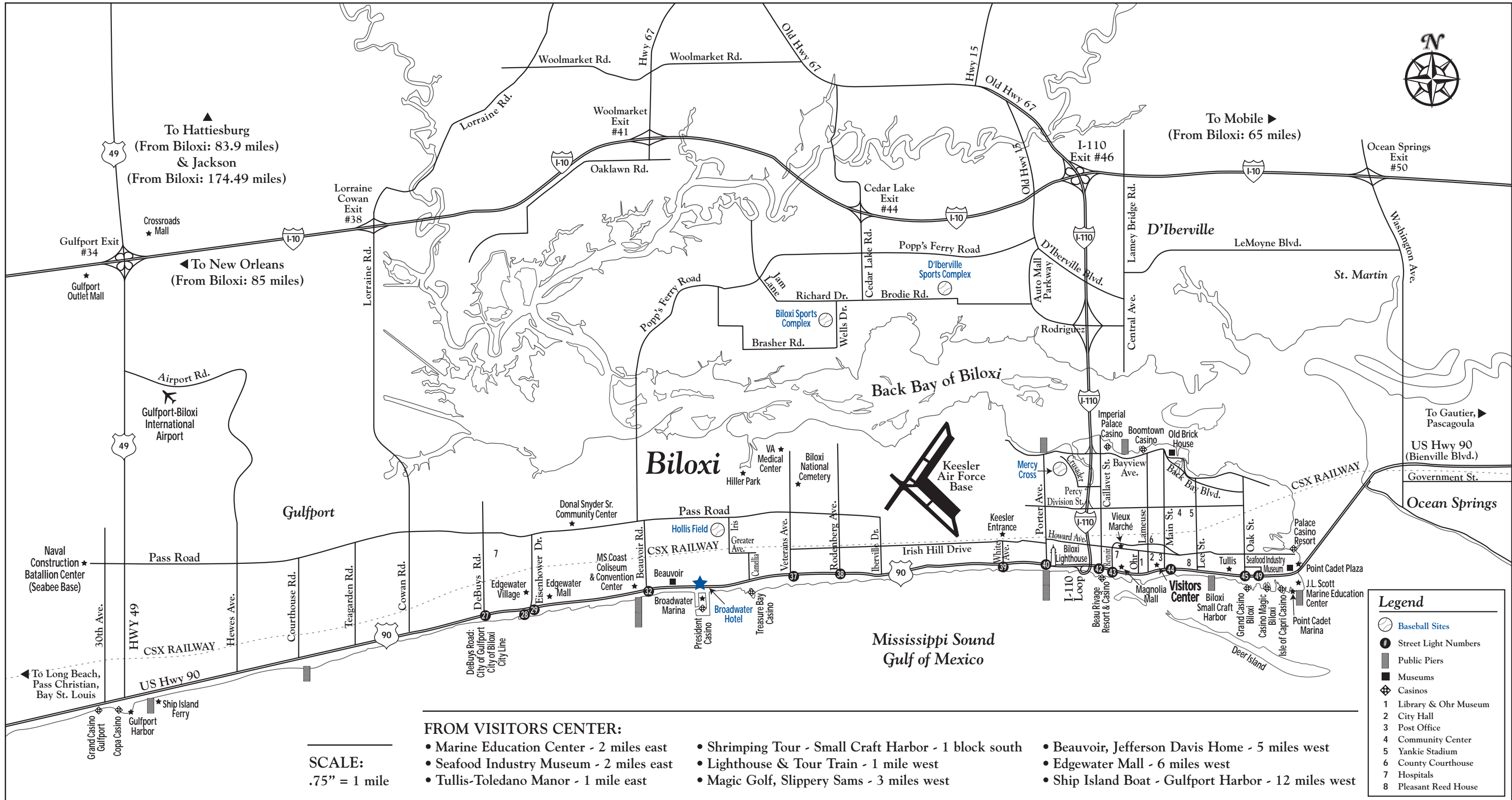




Welcome to Biloxi and Mississippi's Gulf Coast

- We're glad that you're visiting our city, and we're confident that you'll enjoy your time here. A few things that you should be aware of:
- Traffic signals on U.S. 90 have now been numbered from Bay St. Louis to the east end of Biloxi. This new feature was designed to help in providing directions.
 - Speed limits on U.S. 90 in Biloxi range from 30 mph to 45 mph. Slower traffic should use right lanes. Parking on U.S. 90 is allowed only in designated parking bays.
 - Unless otherwise marked, right turns are allowed at red lights, after making a complete stop and yielding to oncoming traffic.
