Gulf Coast School of Art Takes Students on Educational Flight through Art

BILOXI, Mississippi (Thursday, May 11, 2017) – Gulf Coast School of Art (GCSA), The Art Institute of Visual Learning, is challenging the minds of young students through fine art education, providing a defined platform for visual learning.

GCSA, a leader in art innovation, is at the forefront of art education with designing an educational model called, ‘*smART*,’ that combines all core subjects with the foundation of art itself.

Introducing state-of-the-art student exhibitions and art studies each academic year, Gulf Coast School of Art presents, “The Study of Birds: A Bird’s-Eye View.” The Fine Art Exhibition will be held on Sunday, May 21 at The Biloxi Visitor’s Center.

Evaluated by GCSA’s fine art department, yearly art studies exist solely to inspire and challenge students across art disciplines to push the boundaries of creativity and mind advancement. Over the 9-month art course, GCSA students are taught the scientific detail of bird feathers, mathematical proportion, as well as, species observation and variation to studying a range of flight forms, determining light sources and even drafting blueprints.

A primary emphasis of all taught curricula is founded on biblical principles that point all of creation back to God, the Creator. Not only are semester art studies centered around biblical teachings, the foundation of all educational factors and services represented at the Gulf Coast School of Art are rooted in this purpose. The exhibit is intended to function as an act of worship in which a body of artists come together to use the gifts God has given to glorify His name and be a witness to the city in which He has placed us.


