RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MET LIFE INSURANCE TO PROVIDE EMPLOYEES WITH
VISION INSURANCE BENEFITS

WHEREAS, the City of Biloxi has received a proposal for vision insurance benefits for City employees and their dependents through Met Life Insurance; and

WHEREAS, after review and consideration, the City believes it to be in the best interest for Met Life Insurance to provide and administer vision insurance plans offered to employees on a voluntary basis who wish to purchase vision insurance products; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Biloxi to offer vision benefit coverage for employees and their dependents with a two (2) year rate guarantee, for the term beginning October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BILOXI, MISSISSIPPI, THAT:

SECTION 1: The statements and conclusions contained in the preamble of this resolution are hereby approved, adopted, and ratified.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and/or Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into and execute the necessary documents with Met Life Insurance to offer and administer vision insurance plans on a voluntary basis.

SECTION 3: The term of the vision insurance coverage with Met Life Insurance will begin October 1, 2026, ending September 30, 2028.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after adoption.
