### A few other notes

- At \$6, Biloxi has the lowest rate for 5,000 gals of water of the nearly 120 cities and towns polled. Highest is Newton (pop. 3,699, near Decatur) at \$55.75. Only 11 are below \$10.
- Only Forest (pop 5,987, midway between Jackson and Meridian), at \$11.48, is lower than Biloxi's \$12.20 fee for 10,000 gals of water. The highest is Newton at \$101.75.
- Only the town of Verona (pop. 3,334, near Tupelo), at \$3.50 has a lower garbage fee than Biloxi's \$5 monthly fee. Highest is Monticello (pop. 1,726, east of Brookhaven) at \$26.75.
