





Community Development Update 07/05/2016

Last week in community development, 57 building permits were issued with a construction valuation of \$611,000, with 11 certificates of occupancy. Building inspectors performed 103 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 100 cases and resolved 108.

This week, the City Council will hear the first reading of a master plan update for Harrah's Casino Resort to add the Blind Tiger Restaurant to the property south of Beach Boulevard. The council will also hold the first reading of a zoning map amendment for property located at 12046 Lorraine Road, to change the zoning from RS-10, Single Family Residential, to NB, Neighborhood Business. The zoning change is necessary to convert the existing structure into a riverside café/bar. The council will also consider a resolution for conditional use to allow the existing duplex located at 136 Comfort Place to be used for two Short Term Rental units.

Also this week, the Biloxi Planning Commission will meet on Thursday to conduct a public hearing concerning the creation of a Health Care Industry Overlay District. House Bill 1537, passed by the Mississippi Legislature in 2012, allows cities with hospitals that meet certain criteria to establish these overlay districts to encourage health care related businesses to locate or expand, providing high quality medical care, while increasing the number of health care related jobs.
