





Community Development Activity Report Aug. 1

Last week in Community Development, the Development Review Committee reviewed site plans for the proposed Citizens Bank to be located at 1830 Popp's Ferry Rd., and for the Gulf Beach RV Park to be located at 2428 Beach Blvd. Both site plans will require minor revisions, and should be approved at the DRC meeting, this week. The DRC is also scheduled to sign off on the site plan, this week, for a new parking lot for Seabreeze Condominiums on Beach Blvd.

On Thursday, an introductory orientation meeting was held for all members of the revised Architectural/Historical Review Commission. The training session was conducted by Historic Administrator Bill Raymond, with new members, Mary Boles, Wallace "Chip" Barnes, and Anthony "Bo" Lamey in attendance. Current Member Courtney Snodgrass, was elected AHRC President, and Kevin Felsher, the new Vice President. The first public hearing of the AHRC will be held this Thursday at 8:30 a.m. There are 12 cases to be considered, including the exterior building design for the proposed Blind Tiger Restaurant.

Finally last week, there were 59 building permits issued with a total construction valuation of \$1.6 million. Certificates of occupancy were issued for nine structures, and licenses were issued for five new businesses. Building inspectors performed 83 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 98 cases, and resolved 147. Among the permits issued, were the new Woolmarket Pharmacy, to be located at the northeast corner of Woolmarket Road and Shriners Boulevard, a new Noodle Bar, for the Hard Rock Casino, two 4-plex apartment buildings, and one new single family house.
