





Community Development Activity Report Aug. 8, 2016

Last week in Community Development, the Development Review Committee approved the site plan for the Gulf Beach RV Park to be located at 2428 Beach Blvd. The proposed park has been designed to create 43 RV sites, with construction scheduled to begin immediately. The DRC also reviewed the site plan for a new parking lot for Seabreeze Condominiums on Beach Blvd. The proposed lot will be located east of the existing structure, and will create additional parking for the current condo owners.

Also last week, the Architectural Historical Review Commission conducted their first meeting, with new members, Mary Boles, Anthony "Bo" Lamey, and Wallace "Chip" Barnes. Of the 12 design applications listed on the agenda, 11 were unanimously approved, including the proposed Blind Tiger Restaurant to be located at 265 Beach Blvd., the new Grotto for St. Michaels Catholic Church at 177 First St., and the sign package for the new Hyatt Place Hotel, currently under construction at 1150 Beach Blvd.

On Thursday, the Planning Commission approved a conditional use application to allow the existing residential structure, located at 1096 Beach Blvd. to be used for short term rental. The recommendation will now go before the City Council for final consideration.

There were 41 building permits issued last week, with a construction valuation of \$574,000. Certificates of occupancy were issued for three structures, and licenses were issued for three new businesses. Building inspectors performed 81 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 139 cases, and resolved 218.
