





Community Development Activity Report July 25, 2016

Last week in Community Development, the City Council voted unanimously to approve an application from Harrah's Casino for a Master Plan Update to allow the construction of a Blind Tiger Restaurant. The proposed restaurant will have 3240 square feet. It will be elevated, and will be located at the south end of the westernmost elevated crosswalk that connects Harrah's to the green space. The exterior building design will require the approval of the Architectural and Historical Review Commission before the project can obtain a building permit.

The City Council also approved three new Architectural and Historical Review Commission members last week so the commission can now resume conducting public hearings for applications from property owners in the Historic Review Districts. The zoning change and conditional use application for a property located at 12046 Lorraine Rd. to convert the existing structure into a riverside café/bar was also approved.

The Development Review Committee accepted an application and site plan to convert the existing structure located at 186 Bohn St. into a working brewery. Once opened, the Biloxi Brewing Company will be an operation that will allow public tours. This week, the DRC will review a site plan for a new Citizens Bank, to be located at 1830 Popp's Ferry Rd. next to the new Walmart Neighborhood Market, and a site plan for a new recreational vehicle park to be located at 2428 Beach Boulevard.

There were 57 building permits issued last week, with a construction valuation of \$2 million. Certificates of occupancy were issued for six structures, with three new business licenses. Building inspectors performed 96 inspections and code enforcement officers opened 170 cases and resolved 128.
