





Last week in Community Development, the City Council voted 6-0 to approve the zoning change request for property located north of Beach Boulevard to accommodate a family friendly amusement development for Margaritaville.

The zoning change application currently before the planning commission for the property south of Hwy 90 was continued for two additional weeks to allow Margaritaville to continue negotiations with the Secretary of State.

Also last week, the Planning Commission approved a conditional use application for Gulf Coast Exotic Auto, LLC to establish an automobile sales outlet for property located at 2782 Fernwood Drive. The recommendation will now go before the City Council for final consideration.

Building construction plans are under review for the proposed Hilton Garden Inn to be located at Beach Boulevard and Dukate Street. Plans were also received last week for four new townhomes and one new single family home.
