



Last week in Community Development, the department issued building permits for two major projects. One was for the construction of a new sales and service building for Camping World RV Center, located at the southeast corner of Shriners Boulevard and I-10. The new center will face the intersection and will expand its display area to cover the entire parcel. Also, the entrance will be relocated to provide better access from Shriners Boulevard.

The second was for the conversion of the former Santa Maria Del Mar apartment structure into the Watermark Hotel. The new 154 unit hotel will include an upscale seafood restaurant and a swimming pool. Both construction projects are scheduled to begin immediately.

The Patio 44 Restaurant, located at Main Street is scheduled to open to the public today. Also, a meeting is scheduled later this week with the developers of the La Quinta Inn & Suites to finalize details concerning the building permit for the proposed hotel to be located at Beach Boulevard and Hopkins.
