





Last week in Community Development, the Architectural-Historical Review Commission voted unanimously to approve the architectural design for the proposed Hilton Garden Inn to be constructed at 648 Beach Boulevard. The site plan for the proposed 100 unit hotel will return to the Development Review Committee on Wednesday for final signatures. Building Construction plans should be submitted within the next two weeks. The developers are hopeful; the hotel will be open in time for Cruisin' the Coast next year (2017). The AHRC also approved the sign package for the Patio 44 Restaurant at 124 Main Street that is scheduled to open in early December.

Also last week in Community Development, building permits were issued for three new single family houses. A certificate of occupancy was issued for the Hyatt Place Hotel on Beach Boulevard.

This week, the Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing to consider changing the zoning for approximately 23.3 acres of property surrounding the new Margaritaville Resort. The zoning change from WF-Waterfront, to CB-Community Business is needed to encourage family entertainment amusement development projects. The commission will also conduct a public hearing to consider an application for a text and map amendment to the Land Development Ordinance for Waterfront Design Standards and Guidelines for a proposed Overlay District in east Biloxi.
