





Last week in Community Development, the Development Review Committee considered site plans for a proposed Dunkin' Doughnuts at the northwest corner of Cedar Lake Road and Popp's Ferry Road, a Subway Restaurant at 8195 Woolmarket Road, a Waffle House at 618 Beach Boulevard, and a parking lot expansion for Sea Breeze Condominiums on Beach Boulevard.

Building construction plans were submitted for the Watermark Hotel (formerly the Santa Maria Del Mar), a proposed 154 unit conversion, the proposed La Quinta Hotel (4 stories, 66 units) to be located at Beach Boulevard and Hopkins, and the proposed expansion of Camping World RV Sales and Service located at the southeast corner of I-10 and Shriners Boulevard.

Building permits were issued for five new single family houses.

This week the City Council will conduct the first reading for a zoning change from Waterfront to Community Business for property located north of Beach Boulevard between Pine Street and Cedar and south of First Street, for a proposed family amusement development. A first reading will also be conducted for proposed Waterfront Design Standards and Guidelines, and for a Waterfront Overlay District proposed for east Biloxi.

On Thursday the Planning Commission will reconvene the continued public hearing to consider a zoning change from WF to CB, for property south of Beach Boulevard, and adjacent to Margaritaville, for the development of a family amusement development.
