





Final Inspections were conducted at the new Hyatt Place Hotel, and at Big Play Bowling Lanes. Both projects are completing punch list items and should receive their certificates of occupancy in time for Crusin' the Coast.

Permits issued were for City Gear, a new retail tenant in Edgewater Mall, a subcontractor permit for Gulf Coast RV Resort, and 4 new single family houses.

The Development Review Committee conducted their first review of a site plan for the proposed Beach View Villas, a 124 unit apartment complex to be located on the former Breakers Inn property. The apartment complex will be the first phase of a multi-phase development which is designed to include the apartments, a hotel, and a restaurant.

The Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing to consider an application to change the zoning for the former Santa Maria Del Mar property from Neighborhood Business to Community Business to convert the existing structure into a luxury hotel. The properties included in the application are located at 662 / 674 Beach Blvd. and 661 Water St. The commission will also consider an application to change zoning for property located on Beach Boulevard, adjacent to the existing Margaritaville Resort, from Waterfront to Community Business to accommodate a planned family entertainment venue. The hearings will be held at 2 p.m. on Thursday at the Community Development Auditorium.
