





Last week in Community Development, the City Council voted unanimously to approve the ordinance creating a new Health Care Industry Overlay Classification and District. The new district will provide financial incentives for eligible, new and improved medical facilities located within a 5 mile radius of Merit Health Hospital at 150 Reynoir Street. The Council also conducted the first reading of an application for a proposed map amendment to change the zoning for the former Santa Maria Del Mar property from NB-Neighborhood Business to CB-Community Business. The zoning change is necessary to convert the existing structure into a luxury hotel. The proposed hotel will have 154 suites. The second reading will be held at the City Council meeting on Oct. 4.

Also last week, the building department issued a building permit for the new Citizens Bank to be constructed on Popp's Ferry Road. The new bank will be located on the northwest corner of the new boulevard next to the new Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market. A building permit was also issued for a new warehouse for Southern Supply Company located at 326 Howard Avenue, and build-out permits were issued for Tuesday Morning, Hibbett Sports, and a T-Mobile Sales Center, all to be located in the Edgewater Village Shopping Center on Eisenhower Drive.
