





Construction continued to wind down on the Hyatt Place Hotel and the Big Play Bowling Lanes on Beach Boulevard. Weather permitting, both should receive temporary certificates of occupancy within the next 2 weeks. Construction plans were received for a new Dollar General Store on Old Highway 67 near Hudson Krohn Road, and one new single family house.

The Architectural Historical Review Commission's next scheduled meeting is Thursday, Sept. 8.

The Development Review Committee did not meet on Wednesday, Aug. 31, 2016. The next scheduled meeting is Wednesday, Sept. 7 and the DRC will review a site plan for the Beach View Villas, a proposed 124 unit apartment complex, to be located at 2508 Beach Blvd.

The Planning Commission met on Thursday, Sept. 1 and by recommendation vote, agreed on an amendment to the firework sale ordinance.
