







Community Development update for Feb. 29-March 4, 2016

In Community Development, the building department issued the building permit for Woody's Roadside Grill, to be located at Beach Boulevard and Althea. A site work permit had previously been issued to allow the contractor to grade and fill the site. Also, building plans were received for the new sanctuary for Saint Mary's Catholic Church, located on Woolmarket Road. The addition of the sanctuary will increase the overall size of the church from 10,000 to 17,000 sq. ft.. The site work has already begun. Building plans were also received for 2 new single family houses.

The planning commission approved a conditional use application to allow an auto sales outlet to be established at 1749 Pass Road. The application will now go before the city council for final consideration. This week at DRC, the committee will review an application for a proposed RV Park to be located at 2428 Beach Boulevard. The new park is designed to have 51 RV spaces.

Business licenses were issued for 8 new businesses, and 10 renewals. 61 building permits were issued with a total valuation of \$1.4 million dollars, and certificates of occupancy were issued for 16 structures. Building Inspectors performed 111 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 216 cases and resolved 87.
