




Community Development update for week of March 14-18, 2016

The building department issued the building permit for a new sanctuary for Saint Mary's Catholic Church located at 8343 Old Woolmarket Road. The new sanctuary will increase the square footage of the existing structure from 10,000 to 17,000 sq. ft. The building permit also was issued for the "Dawg House", a new pet care facility to be located at 181 Hopkins Boulevard. Both projects are scheduled to start construction immediately. Building permits were also issued for 2 new single family houses, and plans were submitted for 2 more.

On Wednesday, the Development Review Committee (DRC) reviewed the site plan for a proposed 51- lot RV park to be located on Beach Boulevard, south of Beach View Avenue. The site plan will be resubmitted after recommended revisions are complete. For the week, 69 building permits were issued with a construction valuation of \$2.6 million dollars, and certificates of occupancy were issued for 16 structures. Business licenses were issued for 6 new businesses, 2 changes of ownership, and 2 renewals. Building inspectors performed 98 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 177 cases and resolved 220.
