



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



Community Development update for week of March 7-11, 2016

The Architectural Historical Review Commission (AHRC) approved the architectural designs for the proposed Patio 44 Restaurant to be located downtown at Main and Water Streets, north of McDonalds. Although minor revisions were recommended, the developer agreed to comply. The DRC case to review an RV park between Beach Boulevard and Beach View Drive, scheduled was rescheduled for this Wednesday. Certificates of Occupancy were issued last week for Taco Sombrero on Pass Road, O'Malley's Restaurant in the former VooDoo Restaurant location on Lameuse Street, and the new Sales and Construction Office for Butler Homes on Lorraine Road.

Building plan reviews were completed for the "Dawg House" a pet care facility to be constructed on Hopkins Boulevard, north of Howard Avenue. Building Plans were submitted for 3 new single family houses The Building Department issued 51 building permits with a construction valuation of \$768,400. Certificates of occupancy were issued for 11 structures. Business licenses were issued for 6 new businesses and 7 renewals. Building Inspectors performed 97 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 651 cases and resolved 153.
