







Community Development Update 4/25/2016

Last week in community development, the building department issued building permits for the new Biloxi Junior School to be located on Jam Lane, and for the new Patio 44 Restaurant to be located downtown. Site work began this morning for the new restaurant, and has been underway for several months on the new school. Building permits were also issued for 4 new single family houses.

Also last week, the Development Review Committee reviewed the site plan application for a new pharmacy to be located at Shriners Boulevard and Woolmarket Road. DRC also conducted the follow-up review for the Blind Tiger Restaurant to be located in east Biloxi. This week, DRC will review site plans for a Cheeky Monkey Cake Company to be located on DeBuys Road, a new construction office for Mike Fritz on Croesus Street in downtown, and Southport Line Restaurant to be located in the existing structure at 647 Howard Avenue.

This Thursday, the Architectural Historical Review Commission will review the exterior designs for the proposed La Quinta Hotel to be located at Beach and Hopkins Boulevards. 50 building permits, with a total construction valuation of \$27 million dollars, were issued last week and 7 certificates of occupancy. Building Inspectors performed 86 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 343 cases and resolved 125.
