





Community Development update for March 28-April 3, 2016

This week in community development, the developers for the former Casino Magic announced their intention to become Margaritaville Resort Biloxi. The new resort will have 600 employees, and will include 373 hotel rooms, dining and entertainment, a resort pool with many water features, and a number of other family oriented amenities. Grand Opening is scheduled for late Spring.

At DRC last week , the committee approved site plans for the Patio 44 Restaurant to be located downtown, at Main and Water Streets. The committee also approved the site plan for a new Dollar General Store to be located on Old Highway 67, west of Hudson-Krohn Road. Building plans were submitted last week for the new Biloxi Junior High School on Jam Lane, and for a new Buckle Store in Edgewater Mall.

64 building permits and 7 certificates of occupancy were issued last week. Business licenses were issued for 2 new business and 6 renewals. Building Inspectors performed 113 building inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 149 cases and resolved 326
