







Community Development update for April 4-10, 2016

This week in community development, the Development Review Committee will review an application for the proposed Blind Tiger Restaurant, to be located on the south side of Beach Boulevard at Oak Street. The restaurant is design to have 9040 sq. ft., of which, 4960 will be open deck area, and will have a dining area, main bar, and VIP room. The menu will include seafood, steaks and sandwiches.

Building plans review was completed for the Buckle Store to be located in Edgewater Mall. Building plans were submitted for the Patio 44 Restaurant, to be located downtown, and 2 new single family houses. Partial plans were submitted for the interior build out of Margaritaville, and plans review continues for the new Biloxi Jr. High School. The building department issued 71 building permits last week, with a construction valuation of \$621,500.00, and 6 certificates of occupancy. Business licenses were issued for 3 new businesses, and 7 renewals. Building inspectors performed 85 inspections and code enforcement officers opened 113 cases and resolved 145.
