

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



Community Development Update 5/23/2016

Last week in Community Development, the Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve applications for a zoning change, and conditional use permit, for property located at 1378 and 1388 Beach Boulevard. The zoning change from RS-7.5, Single Family Residential, to RM-30, Multi-Family Residential, was requested by the owner, to allow the existing structure to be used for Short Term Rental. The Commission also voted to approved a conditional use application for a drug treatment facility to be located in the existing structure at 1989 Pass Road. Both recommendations for approval will now go before the City Council for final consideration. The Zoning Board of Adjustments and Appeals, voted 7-4 to table their decision on an application for setback variances for the proposed La Quinta Hotel, until the appeal of the AHRC approval of the exterior design is resolved.

Also last week, the Development Review Committee approved the site plan for the proposed Woolmarket Pharmacy to be located at 13034 Shriners Boulevard. This week, the DRC will review the site plan for the Popp's Ferry Causeway Park, and a new office building on Kylie Cove. During the week, the department issued 109 building permits with a construction valuation of \$302,150. Six certificates of occupancy were issued, including Wentzel's Seafood Restaurant on Beach Boulevard, and the Almost Circle Art Gallery at 128 Rue Magnolia. Business licenses were issued for 3 new businesses, with 1 renewal. Building inspectors performed 101 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 125 cases and resolved 340.
