



Community Development Update 6/27/2016

Last week in community development, came the long awaited opening of the new Margaritaville Resort.

The new family entertainment venue, with an arcade, waterpark, restaurants, retail, and other amenities, also added another 373 hotel rooms to our non-casino inventory, which now totals 2275. The total number of casino hotel rooms is 4923.

Also last week, the Development Review Committee reviewed the preliminary site plan for the proposed Hilton Garden Inn to be located on the former Specialty Hospital property at the northeast corner of Dukate Street and Beach Boulevard. The proposed hotel will be designed to have 100 hotel rooms.

54 building permits were issued last week with a construction valuation of \$702,150. There were also eight certificates of occupancy, and 15 business licenses issued. Building inspectors performed 92 inspections, and code enforcement officers opened 186 cases and resolved 275.
