





## **Community Development Update 6/13/2016**

Last week in Community Development, came the long awaited announcement concerning the proposed Foxwood's Resort Casino at Biloxi Pointe (currently Biloxi Boardwalk). The \$265 million dollar development, proposed by owner/developer Chris Ferrara, will include 50,000 sq. ft. of gaming space, a 500 room hotel, 71,000 sq. ft. of meeting and exhibition space, restaurants, retail, and a number of other resort amenities. On Wednesday, the Walmart Neighborhood Market and Fuel Center opened their new location on Popp's Ferry Road.

Also last week, the Architectural Historical Review Commission, approved a design application from owner Mike Fritz to construct a new 2-story office building at the southeast corner of Jackson and Croesus Streets. The historically designed structure, will have 2 commercial office spaces on the first floor, and 2 market rate apartments on the second level. The proposed project is currently awaiting DRC approval.

On Friday, six, of the seven, newly appointed members of the Tree Committee met with the City Arborist and the Director of Community Development to discuss their roles and responsibilities under the new Tree Ordinance. The new committee will play a vital role in the development process of balancing economic development with tree protection and mitigation.

At the city council meeting this week, the council will hear the second reading of an application for a zoning change from RS-7.5 to RM-30, for property located at 1378 and 1388 Beach Boulevard, along with a conditional use application for short term rental for the existing residential structure located at 1378. The council will also conduct the appeal hearing concerning the design of the proposed La Quinta Inn and Suites to be located at 950/ 956 Beach Boulevard. On Thursday, the planning commission will conduct the public hearing for the proposed Blind Tiger Restaurant to be located on Beach Boulevard south of Harrah's.

Lastly, the department issued 56 building permits with a construction valuation of \$575,000. Certificates of Occupancy were issued for 5 structures, and business licenses were issued for 6 new businesses. Building inspectors performed 77 building inspections.
